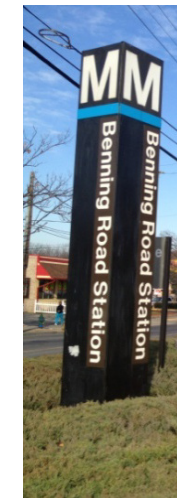

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) are preparing an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the proposed Benning Road and Bridge Multi-modal Transportation Improvements per the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). The project will also include evaluation of historic resources per Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.

The study area is along Benning Road NE from Oklahoma Avenue to the Minnesota Avenue and Benning Road Metrorail Stations. You are invited to attend a public scoping meeting to learn about the project, its scope, and discuss transportation issues.

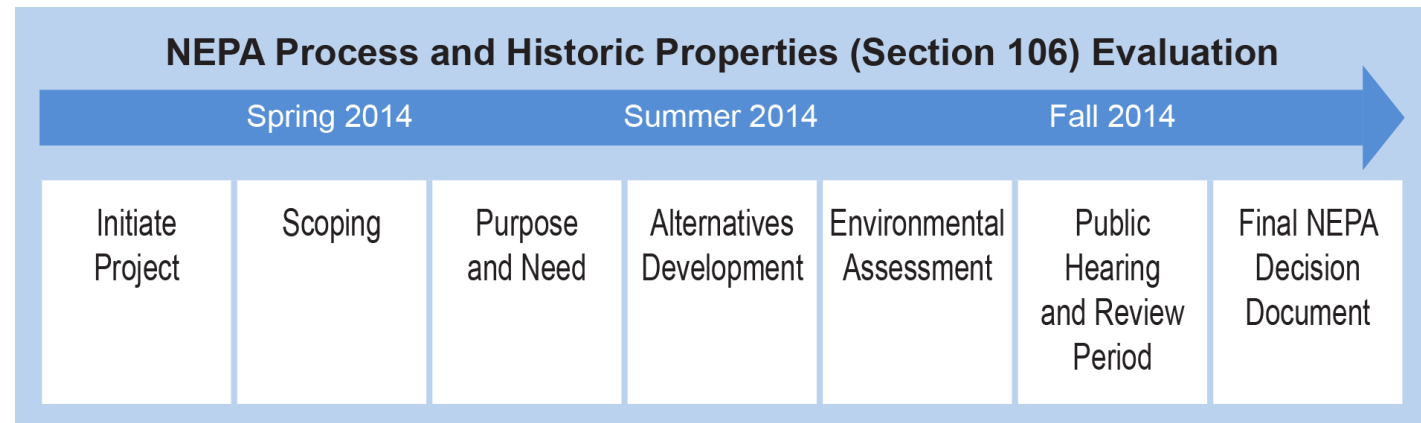
